Proposed Change:	Recommend that a Secondary Unit of Measure of Gross Square Feet (GSF) be authorized for OSF Usage Code 5769, Towers (Chill Water). The GSF measurement for these structures would be limited to the actual footprint (i.e., perimeter) occupied by the tower.				
Justification:	Many cooling towers associated with nuclear production and processing facilities are typically very large structures and occupy a significant footprint on the land. Since these structures are an integral part of the primary structure (i.e., Reactor Building, etc.), they should also use the same units of measure. Assignment of a secondary unit of measure of GSF for these facilities will allow these structures to be recognized for their significant contribution to site footprint reduction.
