Proposed Change:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Create a new building usage code heading "28 Museums and Memorials (No Entry)."</li> <li>2. Revise the usage code 293 definition to add the underlined clause so that it reads: "293 MUSEUMS/SHRINES/NATIONAL LANDMARKS/HISTORIC BUILDINGS - Buildings that display artifacts, or are themselves historically significant <u>but do not comprise a portion of the Manhattan Project National Historical Park.</u>"</li> <li>3. Revise the usage code 2919 definition to add the underlined clause so that it reads: "2919 STRUCTURES, MONUMENTS AND MEMORIALS (Primary Unit of Measure = Each) - Memorial stones, statues, or structures erected in remembrance of persons or events <u>not to include Manhattan Project National Historical Park structures.</u>"</li> <li>4. Migrate all records citing usage code 293 MUSEUMS/SHRINES/NATIONAL LANDMARKS/HISTORIC BUILDINGS to new usage code 282 MUSEUMS/SHRINES/NATIONAL LANDMARKS/HISTORIC BUILDINGS. Then delete usage code 293 to free it for a future application.</li> <li>5. Create a new usage code: "283 MANHATTAN PROJECT NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK BUILDINGS – Buildings that display artifacts or are themselves historically significant and comprise a portion of the Manhattan Project National Historical Park."</li> <li>6. Create a new usage code: "2918 MANHATTAN PROJECT NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK STRUCTURES (Primary Unit of Measure = Each) - Memorial stones, statues, or structures associated with the Manhattan Project National Historical Park."</li> </ol>
