SUBJECT: Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) Version 2.23 Release

Today, Tuesday, January 20, 2015, version 2.23 of the Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) was released. The URL to access the FIMS application is <https://fimsweb.doe.gov>. This release addresses the following enhancements which will automatically be available when you log into FIMS from your browser. The Change Request can be found on the FIMS informational website (http://fimsinfo.doe.gov/change_requests.htm).

- The Data Validation reports/forms have been modified to align with the FY15 Data Validation Guidance as follows:
 - 068 Bridge Safety Inspection Report – modified to add Location Zip Code and Year Built and
 - 069 Random Asset Generator – updated to incorporate the FY15 data fields to be validated
 - 069a DOE Leased and GSA Assets – modified to include GSA Owned and GSA Leased assets and to incorporate the FY15 data fields to be validated
 - 069c Archived/Disposed – new report/form created for the FY15 Data Validations
 - Report 070b FRPC Element Report has been renumbered to 070 FRPC Element Report
 - Reports 070a Building Outlier Report and 070e OSF Outlier Report have been removed. The FIMS Ad Hoc query tool can be used to identify building, trailer and OSF 'Outliers' for inclusion in the DOE Owned Data Validation form
 - The Data Validation page on the FIMS website (http://fimsinfo.doe.gov/data_validation.htm) has been updated to include FY2015 Data Validation materials

- Mission Dependency has been enabled and made optional for the following property types and ownerships as requested by Change Request 14-14. Mission Dependency was previously

enabled for GSA Owned and GSA Leased buildings. NNSA sites will be required to populate this optional data field.

- Buildings – Contractor License, Permits
 - Trailers – Contractor License
 - OSF – Contractor License, Permits
 - Land – Institutional Control, Contractor License

- The FIMS Usage Code / RPV Model Crosswalk found in Appendix F of the FIMS User's Guide has been updated to reflect the recently added new building Usage Codes. This table has been updated for use during the FY2015 Data Validations.
